The PCCA (mountain bike leader) qualification not only offers a recognised national coach award but also a cycling leader award in the same package, the qualification is user friendly for the services and has been adopted by the Army Physical Training Corps APTC for their Continued Personal Development CPD courses.

INFORMATION FOR MILITARY PERSONNEL

1. The course is two days long when run for 6 students by 1 instructor.
2. Candidates should be experienced cyclists with at least twenty days Trail riding experience and or other disciplines i.e. Road, BMX etc.
3. Course qualifies for Standard learning credits to cover costs.
4. Qualification limited to familiar lowland worldwide unless otherwise stated i.e. ML Award or CO's directive.
5. Registered and insured by the Association of British Cycling Coaches worldwide.
6. Recommended and endorsed by Adventure Activities Licensing Services AALS
7. Over three hundred and fifty military personnel already qualified.
8. Course run at Ripon, N York's or external venue by arrangement.
9. Endorsed by MIAS Mountain Bike Instructors Scheme for MIAS awards
10. Military 1st Aid qualification should be held (MATTS) unless working with civilians
11. Course costs £154 with ABCC annual registration and Insurance. Subject to additional expenses if course is externally run.
